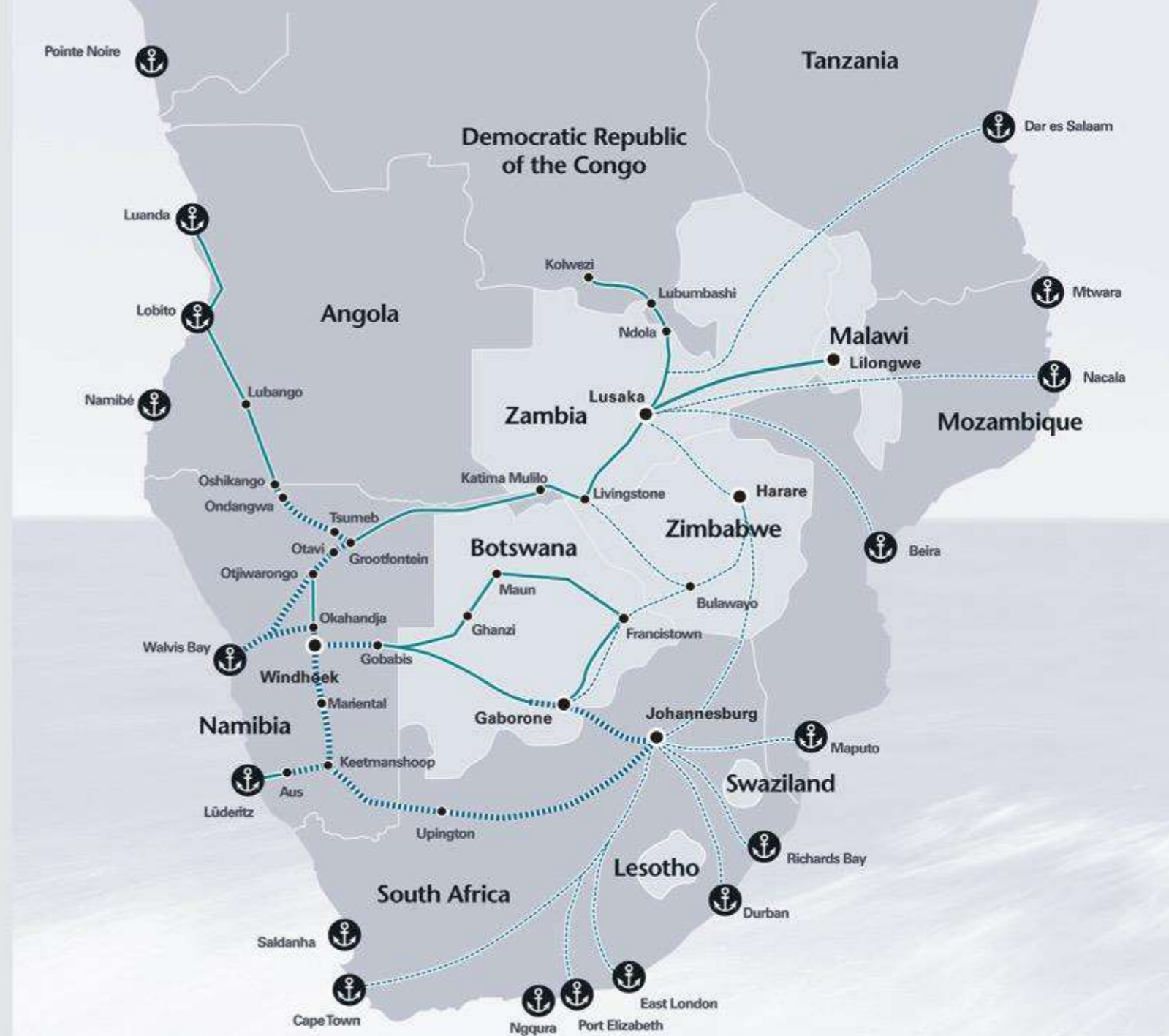

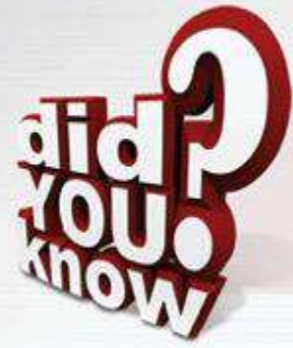
- offers opportunities for investment in infrastructure through PPPs or foreign direct investment.

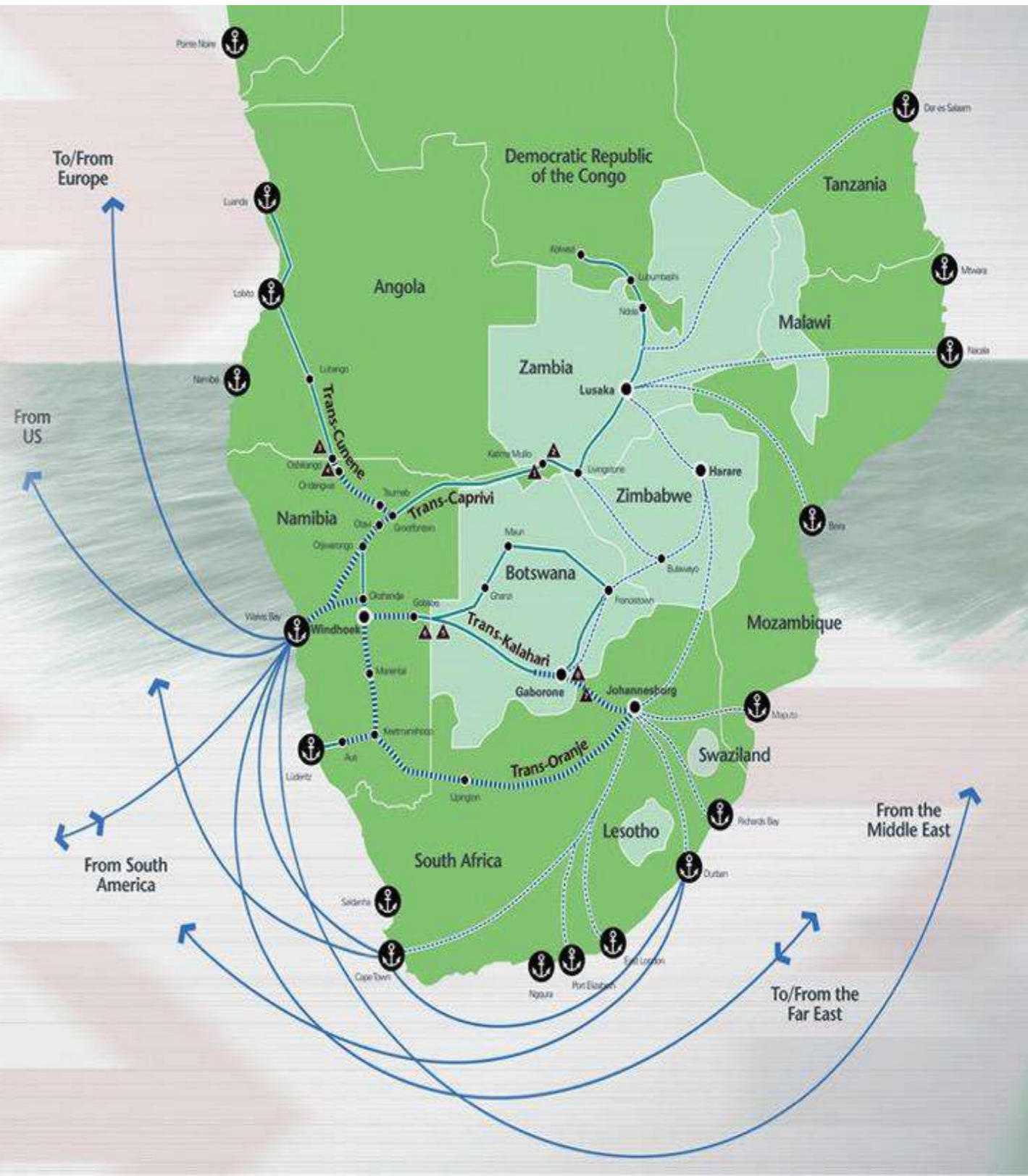
